



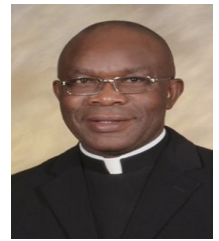

# REFLECTIONS SEPTEMBER 24, 2017

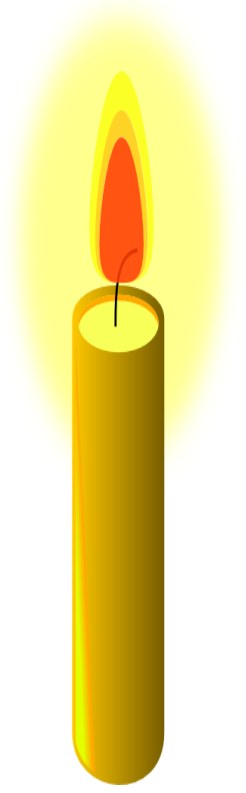
Do you every once in a while question the decision / s of God in your life?

This is for the reason that He paid the workers the same amount regardless of the time they've labored in his vineyard. Was he really unfair to the other workers who worked for longer hours or he was simply generous?

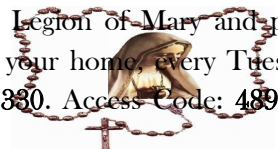
